We are currently looking for adults to be part of research studies that will look at the effects of various interventions for gum disease.

A screening visit is necessary to see if you qualify

To qualify, you must:

- **Be over the age of 18**
- **Be a non-smoker or willing to give up smoking for 6 weeks**
- **Have a minimum of 20 natural teeth, not including wisdom teeth**
- **Be in good general health**
- **Not take antibiotics for dental treatment**
- **Not use anti-inflammatory medicines (e.g. Advil, Aleve, Relafin)**
- **Have no chronic diseases (e.g. diabetes, autoimmune, liver disorders)**
- **Not be pregnant or breast feeding**
- **Women of child bearing age must use birth control during the study**
- **Not have braces or permanent retainers**
